In Caribbean SIDS alone, the development potential for solar PV is estimated at nearly 72 GW, equivalent to the installed solar PV capacity for all of Latin America in 2023.

Which small island countries have a net zero climate goal?

Many small island countries and territories have ambitious climate goals. Antigua and Barbuda, Fiji and the Maldives are among those that have set net zero targets via pledges, declarations, policies or laws. However, implementation is often lagging due to challenges in attracting the necessary investments.
