

# 16 Root Canal Solar Support

Is root canal treatment safe?

What is a root canal treatment guide?

Should I get a dental bridge or a root canal?

There are four major types of dental bridges: traditional, cantilever, Maryland, and implant-supported, each anchored to the mouth in a different way.

Why is root canal irrigation important in endodontics?

In Endodontics, proper root canal irrigation is mandatory to facilitate instrumentation through lubricating, to remove debris and the smear layer, to prevent apical debris packing impeding complete instrumentation and to disinfect

How long does endodontic (root canal) treatment last?

Teeth that have had endodontic (root canal) treatment can last as long as natural teeth, however, in some cases the treatment can fail or symptoms can persist. This may happen shortly after the treatment has been performed or even years following the treatment.

What is active irrigation in endodontics?

Active irrigation in Endodontics can be defined as using "...method to agitate and improve the flow of irrigants to the intricacies of the root canal system by mechanical or other energy forms". 3 Why should you switch to active irrigation?

This procedure is impossible with current endodontic instruments. The designed treatment for root canals intentionally entombs bacteria and remnants of pulp tissue. Hence, 99% of root canals are still ...
