

How to install solar panels?

Make space for the solar panel accessories (solar inverter, cables and solar batteries, if desired), for instance in a plant room 4. Plan a day for installation 5. Erect the scaffolding (this can be done by your supplier or by a company you organise) 6. The solar panel mounts will be installed 7. The professionals will install the solar panels 8.

Should I install solar panels on my roof?

Solar installation is complex, and you don't want to jeopardize such a costly investment. Take the time to properly think through and set up your project before beginning. First, check that your property is suitable for a solar power system. Your roof needs to have enough surface area for the panels required to supply your energy needs.

Can solar panels be installed on a house?

If you're getting solar panels installed onto the roof of your house, the installers will need to construct scaffolding around the building before they can crack on with the process. This will take the most time out of all the steps - usually about a day - but will mean the installers can have safe and secure access to the roof.

Can solar panels be installed vertically or horizontally?

The panels themselves can be installed vertically or horizontally. Once the mounting system is set up,it's time for the moment we've all been waiting for: getting the solar panels onto the roof. Your installer will start by placing the solar panels onto the mounting system, without fully securing them just yet.
