How much does battery storage cost?

The suite of publications demonstrates wide variation in projected cost reductions for battery storage over time. We use the recent publications to create low, mid, and high cost projections. Projected storage costs are \$245/kWh, \$326/kWh, and \$403/kWh in 2030 and \$159/kWh, \$226/kWh, and \$348/kWh in 2050.

The projections are developed from an analysis of recent publications that include utility-scale storage costs. What is a good round-trip efficiency for battery storage?

The round-trip efficiency is chosen to be 85%, which is well aligned with published values. Battery storage costs have evolved rapidly over the past several years, necessitating an update to storage cost projections used in long-term planning models and other activities.

How do you convert kWh costs to kW costs?

The \$/kWh costs we report can be converted to \$/kW costs simply by multiplying by the duration (e.g., a \$300/kWh, 4-hour battery would have a power capacity cost of \$1200/kW). To develop cost projections, storage costs were normalized to their 2022 value such that each projection started with a value of 1 in 2022.

How do I calculate energy storage based on cost lines?

You can add all of the cost lines together (in \$) and divide them by the total power rating in kW (yielding a \$/kW metric). Or you can add all of the cost lines together (in \$) and divide them by the total energy storage in kWh (yielding a \$/kWh metric).

Lithium-ion battery costs for stationary applications could fall to below USD 200 per kilowatt-hour by 2030 for installed systems. Battery storage in stationary applications looks set to grow from only 2 gigawatts (GW) worldwide in 2017 to around 175 GW, rivalling pumped-hydro storage, projected to reach 235 GW in 2030.

The 10 kWh battery can provide this energy, which supports appliances, lighting, and heating or cooling systems. Moreover, the capacity of a 10 kWh battery typically meets the average daily energy needs of a household. Most homes consume around 30 kWh per day, which means a 10 kWh battery can cover roughly

Grid-scale battery costs can be measured in \$/kW or \$/kWh terms. Thinking in kW terms is more helpful for modelling grid resiliency. A good rule of thumb is that grid-scale lithium ion batteries will have 4-hours of storage duration, as this minimizes per kW costs and maximizes the revenue potential from power price arbitrage.
