What is WeChat Pay?

WeChat Pay is a payment feature integrated into the WeChat app, allowing users to complete payments quickly and securely on their mobile phones. Users can link their bank cards, receive and transfer money, pay bills, and make purchases both in-store and online. Download WeChat from the App Store or Google Play.

How to fix WeChat Pay?

1. Withdraw all your money from WeChat in Balance > Withdraw 2. Go to Payment Management (the 3 dots on the top of the Pay page) and cancel all 'Auto-Deduction Services'. 3. Delete all linked bank cards. 4. Go to 'Payment Management' again and cancel WeChat Pay. Any other points to be aware of after going through this process to fix WeChat Pay?

Why can't I use WeChat Pay anymore?

Due to the complexity of opening a new bank account, etc, some users may choose not to use WeChat pay anymore. If that's the case, keep in mind that China has other payment options. Notably, WeChat Pay's greatest competitor Alipay.

How to cancel WeChat Pay if you can't add two cards?

Yes, mafan! If you can't add two cards, the temporary trick is to cancel WeChat Pay and re-verify your ID and bank card details to register again. Follow these steps and you are good to go: Step 1: Withdraw WeChat balance to zero. You can withdraw the money in the wallet to your bank card. Delete linked cards. Step 2: Cancel WeChat Pay

Can foreigners use WeChat Pay?

Foreigners can link international credit cards (Visa, MasterCard) to WeChat Pay. Input your card details, and ensure your card supports international transactions. Verification might involve a small transaction to confirm the card's validity. If you have a Chinese bank account, you can directly top up your WeChat wallet from this account.

Does WeChat Pay require real-name authentication?

In order to comply with relevant laws and regulations, WeChat Pay now requires real-name authentication for all users. For WeChat Pay users who don't have a China's Mainland ID card, you must provide your identity information.
