

#### Can solar energy reduce fossil fuel costs in Greenland?

Dramatic and ongoing reductions in the cost of solar energy and battery storage combined with copious sunlight for seven months of the year suggest that solar and storage could play an important role in reducing costsand dependence on fossil fuels in Greenland and elsewhere in the far north.

#### Should Greenland invest in solar energy?

Even without a change in the one-price model, government investment in solar energy for communities around Greenland will lower Nukissiorfiit's dependence on fossil fuel which would help to reduce the associated large ongoing deficits incurred by Nukissiorfiit . #### How much do solar panels cost in Greenland?

Solar power is not widely used in the far north of Greenland. Therefore, there is little comparison for costs of panels, transportation, and installation. In Sarfannguit, Greenland, PV prices were estimated at 2800 USD/kWin 2014 . In the Canadian Arctic, panel price estimates have exceeded 5000 USD/kW in 2019 and 2020 ,.

#### Is solar feasible in Greenland?

How much energy is needed in Greenland in 2050?

In 2050, curtailment of about 4% of the total electricity generation is required, a value known if three renewable resources complement each other in a sector coupled energy system. In the reference system, a major share of heating in Greenland is supplied by district heating, which is dominant in larger towns.

#### Should Greenland invest in wind and nuclear energy?
