

Can a Mixergy hot water tank use solar energy?

### How does a solar PV system work?

The device ensures that you make the most of the energy your solar PV array generates even when you are not at home. As long as your hot water tank has enough capacity which you can achieve by setting the normal hot water heating to come on after the sun has gone down, you may be able to use 100% of the electricity generated by your PV system.

#### How does a solar hot water system work?

Most solar hot water systems are just designed to provide the hot water you use for bathing, showering and hot taps. Solar water heating systems use panels or tubes, called solar collectors, to gather solar energy. The solar collectors convert the infra-red portion of visible light into heat. They are filled with a mix of water and glycol.

#### How do I make the most of my solar hot water system?

Make the most from your solar hot water system by following these tips: Use as much hot water as possible from the solar-heated supply, rather than heating it up with an appliance using electricity. For example, fit a mixer shower (rather than electric). Change your habits to use more hot water - showers, baths and washing up - in the evenings.

#### Can a solar PV system benefit from free hot water?

Many UK homeowners have Solar PV installed to benefit from greener electricity. But what if I was to tell you that you could also use your Solar PV to be benefit from free hot water. Most homeowners won't use all of the Solar energy that their Solar PV system generates, leaving a surplus amount being exported back to the Grid.

#### Do you need a solar inverter for water heating?

These systems have a solar panel inverter that converts Direct Current (DC) from the solar panels into Alternating Current (AC) that can be used in your home or business. Solar thermal panels, meanwhile, generate heating and hot water from energy from the sun. These are the panels you'll need for solar water heating.
