What is a solar panel used in a home?

Solar panels don't need direct sunlight and can work on cloudy days.

Why should you choose a solar panel system?

Sunlight is free, so once you've paid for the initial installation, your electricity costs will be reduced. Solar electricity is low carbon, renewable energy. A typical home solar panel system could save around one tonne of carbon per year, depending on where you live in the UK.

Do you need a solar panel system to be energy independent?

If you want to be fully energy independent, you will need more panels and a solar battery big enough to store the excess energy you generate. As long as you install a solar panel system powerful enough to cover your household's energy usage, you can rely on solar electricity for all your energy needs.
