

Is my roof suitable for solar panels?

If the sun sets in front of you, it's west-facing; if it sets to the left, it's north-facing; and if it sets on the opposite side of the property, it's east-facing. Here's how an installer will decide if your roof is suitable for solar panels, including assessing its direction, usable space, and loft.

How many solar panels can be installed on a roof?

Your roof will need to be large enough to fit a suitable number of solar panels, as there's rarely much point putting just two or three panelsup there. The average solar panel takes up 2m², and your installer should leave around 40cm on each side of the array, as well as 3cm between every panel.

Installing ground-mounted solar systems requires special permits and allowances based on location, and the process can take from a few days to several months.
