Kuwait has a soft target of increasing the share of renewables in total energy demand to about 15% by 2030, up from less than 1% today. #### Will Kuwait replace natural gas for oil?

Kuwait plans to substitute natural gas for oilin the power generation sector in order to retain oil-export revenues for savings and investment. Government plans also encompass increasing the share of renewable energy in the power generation mix.

### What is Kuwait Energy Outlook?

#### Who owns the oil industry in Kuwait?

Kuwait took over ownership of its oil industry in the late 1970s. The government of Kuwaitowns and controls all development of the oil sector. The Prime Minister heads the Supreme Petroleum Council (SPC), which oversees Kuwait's oil sector and sets oil policy.

#### Should Kuwait reevaluate its power generation and desalination plans?

Environmental considerations, cost reductions in renewable energy technologies and higher than expected growth in electricity and water demand could persuade Kuwait to reevaluate its current expansion plans for the power generation and desalination sectors, particularly if MED and RO technologies prove to be more efficient and reliable.
