What is the strategic spatial energy plan (SSEP)?

The Strategic Spatial Energy Plan (SSEP) will help accelerate and optimise the transition to clean, affordable and secure energy across Great Britain by providing greater clarity to industry, investors, consumers and the public on the shape of our future reformed energy system.

What is a spatial energy plan?

Strategic Spatial Energy Plan: The spatial plan will set out a coordinated approach for Great Britain's onshore and offshore energy infrastructure to help cut grid connection waiting times and provide cost-effective energy generation.

What is a strategic spatial plan?

Strategic spatial plan to provide a blueprint for Great Britain's energy infrastructure The location for new energy infrastructure will be set out in a strategic plan to speed up the transition away from fossil fuels and accelerate the government's clean energy superpower mission.

Is SSE supporting the strategic spatial energy plan?

What is a centralised strategic network plan?
