Does New Zealand support PNG's energy sector?

New Zealand has been providing assistance to PNG's energy sector since 2012. This includes a range of feasibility studies exploring the potential for off-grid generation, primarily in hydro, solar and geothermal to inform the PNG Government and PPL; as well as support for the drafting of PNG's Geothermal Policy.

What is the economic potential of PNG?

The economically feasible sites total about 4,200 MW,producing roughly 37,000 GWh/year,which presents a sizeable investment opportunity. These estimates exclude micro- and mini-hydro for rural communities. Geothermal: The geothermal resource potential of PNG is believed to be vast.
