As the sealant ages, it becomes less effective and allows water to leak through. When this happens, it can lead to short-circuiting and may degrade the components of your solar panels.

Can a solar inverter leak if it rains?

The inverter itself could have earth leakage or, if transformerless, could be leaking AC through the array via bonding (roof systems almost never are bonded though), or through the wet building to earth when it rains. Easily eliminated by switching off PV at AC isolator next time.
