Emails offering cheap solar panels or appearing to be backed by a Government scheme could also be scammers, taking you to an seemingly-official website offering free or cheap installation. We're regularly contacted by customers, who have received an unsolicited call or letter from another company, offering them a 'free solar panel health check' or warning about their solar PV system being at risk of failing. This is a common scam.
