The University of Belize has a solar photovoltaic (PV) systemthat supplies 0.1% of the country's electricity supply. Biomass supplies 8.9% of the country's needs, but demand currently exceeds supply of biomass. In 2014, the PUC issued a request for proposals for 60 MW of baseload generating capacity and 15 MW of solar or wind generating capacity.
