

The Xsabo Nkonge Power Station (Xsabo Nkonge Solarline), a US\$22 million 20 MW/AC solar power plant, will be ready for commissioning before the 31 st of March 2024, according to Dr. David Alobo, CEO of Xsabo Group. Registered by the Electricity Regulatory Authority (ERA) in the national gazette for the implementation process following license ...

The project is developed and owned by GL Africa Energy and Xsabo Group. The owners have 50% stake in the project respectively. Kabulasoke Solar PV Park is a ground-mounted solar project which is spread over an area of 130 acres. The electricity generated from the plant has offsetted 21,000t of carbon dioxide emissions (CO2) a year.
